Case Report: A patient with mild Haemophilia A

A plasma sample from a 40-year-old man was send from a local hospital to our lab. The clinical bleeding history of the patient was unclear. In a pre-operative consultation, he told the anaesthesiologist he had once suffered from a mild bleeding of the ankle after falling from his bicycle. Because of the vague bleeding history, and additionally because the normal screening coagulation tests had been performed in the local lab, there was some reservation about sending the sample for further analysis.

The ECAT Foundation, in conjuction with the Erasmus Medical Centre in Rotterdam, The Netherlands has conducted a study on the biological variation of haemostasis variables in thrombosis and bleeding on 40 healthy volunteers.
